RE: DECLARATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE ISSUED FOR FIRE MOUNTAIN FARMS
INC. APPLICATION COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL BIO-SOLIDS PERMIT

Mr. Lyon,

The Schorno Family objects to the Declaration of Non-Significance (DNS) issued for the Fire Mountain Farms (FMF) application under the general permit for Biosolids Management for the property located off of 128th and Bald Hill Rd approximately 265 acres.

The Schorno property also known as the Nisqually Springs farms located at 17835 Hwy 507 SE Yelm, WA 98597 organically farms over 200 acres along the Nisqually River and is located in close proximity and downstream of the proposed subject property.

After reviewing the SEPA checklist that underlines the DNS, it is incomplete and believe that the DNS should be withdrawn and that ALL adverse impacts of the bio-sludge application and long term effects be disclosed prior to any site-specific permit being granted.

We cannot take the risk of having a potentially unsafe biosolids contaminating on our organic farm soils, our artesian water sources, wells and other irrigation resources we currently use to farm.
